Venezuela Now began as a ministry to train church leaders to spread God's Word in this secular nation.

Dr. Warren Lathem, a long-time supporter of missionaries and short-term mission initially travelled to Venezuela to preach a evangelistic crusade, but Venezuelans craved more.

They asked for a seminary to provide theological education to young leaders.

The Seminary was established in 2002 and since that time almost 1000 students have enrolled. Students from the Seminary have formed hundreds of new churches and outreach ministries. As well, Seminary students launched and lead some of the ministries shown in these pages that are supported by Venezuela Now.

EXPANDING MINISTRY EDUCATION

ONLINE

In 2021, a new interactive online platform was launched making classes available to students throughout Venezuela unable to reach the campus. Offsite computer labs facilitate internet access as well as provide a sense of community for the remote students. There are even students enrolled from other Spanish speaking countries.

As a pastor and pediatrician, Dr. Maria envisioned God's will being done through a faith based medical center.

Venezuela's economic crisis has further restricted access to affordable health care.

People die from non-life threatening issues due to lack of care and the scarcity of insulin, antibiotics and basic medications. Without the Wesley Medical Center thousands would be unable to receive the medical care they so desperately need.

Uniquely, a patients' medical care includes pastoral and spiritual care.

With the support of Venezuela Now, the first Protestant medical center in Venezuela was begun in 2014 providing low-cost medical care. In addition, medicines are provided at no cost to the patient. Over 45,000 patients were treated in 2020. In 2021, a fourth location was opened, increasing total medical staffing to 60 people including an internist, psychologist, cardiologist and gastroenterologist.



In order to meet more of the patient needs,

The Wesley Medical Center and Venezuela Now envision

a 45 bed full service hospital ministering healing

and hope to the people of Venezuela.



Una Esperanza (One Hope) Ministry to Vulnerable Girls

There is an epidemic of babies having babies.

Most of these young girls are very poor and have been sexually molested and abandoned.

STD's and HIV/AIDS are rampant. There is minimal access to birth control or medical care. With little education and no means of a livelihood, they have little hope.

Through Una Esperanza, Hope is offered to at risk girls and mothers and babies are provided scarce infant formula offering them a better future.

The economic crisis has left many children homeless in the streets. Pastor Yolanda, a Seminary graduate, built a home for children abandoned by their parents.

Not only are the children in the home ministered to, those in the community are also ministered to with God's Word, distribution of clothing and food, and hygiene education.

Food & Medicine Crate Ministry

The economic crisis has brought scarcity and hyperinflation making many of the basic needs of the average Venezuelan unattainable. In partnership with humanitarian aid organizations, Venezuela Now has access to a wide variety of medicines and basic nutrition at highly discounted rates.

To make a difference, Venezuela Now successfully ships food, medicine, infant formula and supplies to Venezuela from the US. It has all arrived safely and it is distributed through local ministries to those in greatest need.

Churches and donors in the US have sent a cumulative total of over \$7 million in medicine, equipment and supplies. In just 4 years, as the crisis has deepened, food for over 2.6 million meals has been shipped.
